



HISTORIC DOYLESTOWN CEMETERY

Welcome to this beautifully maintained garden cemetery, home to over 11,000 interments since 1850.

The Historic Doylestown Cemetery Walking Tours began in 2012 as a gift to Doylestown's celebration of 200 years of Doylestown becoming the County seat.

Professional curating of the arboretum was begun in 2000, cleaning and restoration of the monuments in 2010, and installation of the professionally landscaped Memorial Garden for the environmentally sensitive interment of cremated remains was completed in 2016.

These projects, as well as the cleaning and restoration of broken and deteriorated historic monuments, are funded in part by proceeds from the Walking Tours.

Doylestown Cemetery is a private, non-profit organization not affiliated with any governmental or religious organization.

Guided walking tours are offered the first week-ends May – Halloween. Saturdays at 10:00 am and Sundays at 1:00 pm. **See our website for details or call 215-348-3911.**

CIVIL WAR TOUR

Meet some of the men who served in the great conflict called the Civil War. Over 200 Civil War veterans are buried here including Generals, US Colored Troops members, US Naval Sailors, and the Surgeon General of the Union Army.

Civil War experts and re-enactors will take you on a journey from Doylestown to the scenes of some of the Wars' most desperate battles.
